


Big Engine Sound with Guns too!

Model Sounds Inc SFX7.0 Sound Module

A sound module with a Micro SD Card that contains 44 aircraft!



The SFX7.0 was released earlier this year by Model Sounds Inc., from Ottawa, Canada (previously known as Model Solutions of Canada, Ltd.). This is their latest 4th generation R/C sound module and is their best one yet.

The system includes a micro-SD card that contains their entire collection of 44 Aircraft, 16 helicopter and 9 tank sounds. You can easily select the specific sound for your electric project.

As an additional feature of the SFX7.0, offers two (2) fully proportional engine sounds for twin engined models, and it is suitable for model airplanes, helicopters, tanks, boats and garden scale trains. The SFX7.0 system is ideal for static and museum displays too!

The SFX7.0 differentiates itself from the competition by offering full 16 bit sound samples at 44100 samples/second compared to the usual 8 bit/22050 that the competition offers.

It sports a built in 40 Watt highly efficient class D power amplifier right on board the small 68mm x 44mm (2.6" X 1.75") footprint, and no heatsink is required. It includes two male-male servo leads to connect to your radio receiver.

A built in Y harness allows the ESC to be also connected directly to the receiver through another set of pins on the board. There are four switched outputs that can flash ultra-bright LEDs in gun ports in sync with the gunfire sounds or can be used to switch auxiliary loads.

Also included is a very easy to use Windows configuration program that allows you to change and add your own sounds or change the many configuration options through its built in mini-USB port.

It comes ready to use and is plug and play. Cost of the SFX7.0 is CAD\$199.95 + shipping.

Your editor watched this unit at the 2012 Scale Master's Championships in Rosewood, Indiana in the 1/4 scale Chilton DW1 flown by Phillip Soden. The crowd as well as myself were totally impressed with the accurate sound and volume level from the SFX7.0. We will have a unit here at Scale Aviator in a few days to install in the Great Planes 86" Top Flite Corsair. We will have a video sound clip in the next edition on this unique sound unit.
